General Order Title: TOBACCO PRODUCTS		

POLICY

It is the policy of the Reno Police Department to not allow the smoking, and to regulate the chewing, of tobacco products within the confines of City of Reno buildings and vehicles.

PROCEDURES

Tobacco smoking is not allowed in the department main building, the Regional Training Center, any of the department substations, and/or any temporary office spaces that are donated or leased for department use.

Tobacco smoking is not allowed in any city-owned or leased vehicles.

Employees chewing tobacco will be discreet and should not use common garbage cans for expectorating their tobacco waste.
